

DEGY SKILLBRIDGE INTERNSHIP

Objective

To open Degy Entertainment's remote internship program to transitioning service members who have a passion for music, entertainment, business, or marketing.

Sessions

While we do take rolling applications, we have 3 specific sessions for the program. Detailed starting dates will be announced closer to each sessions.

Spring: Jan – May
Summer: May – Sept
Fall: Aug – Jan

Since sessions start together, your Skillbridge program will need to align to start in Jan, May, or Sept. Session end dates can be extended to meet specific Skillbridge requirements, but not reduced.

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Research our company

Before you apply, make sure Degy looks like a good fit for you and matches up to your interests and timeline. You can find us here: www.degy.com

2. Read the internship description

3. Send your materials

To apply for our internship, you will need a resume and cover letter detailing why you want to be an intern at Degy. Please email those two documents as PDFs and include the session you'd like to apply for to our internship coordinator, Jessica Hamorsky, at jessica@degy.com

FAQS:

What are the requirements to apply?

No prior training is needed to apply to our internship. We ask those applying to have an interest in the music/entertainment field and want to peruse those fields as a career. You should be open to learning about us as a company and growing your skillset. The internship description under "How to Apply" gives a full list of characteristics we look for.

Since we are a newer Skillbridge partner, we are only taking up to 5 Skillbridge interns a session due to the required workload. Once materials are submitted, select applicants will be invited for an interview for the upcoming session. Decisions for that session will be announced after.

What is the company culture like?

We have a very collaborative and encouraging company culture. As an intern, you can work individually and in groups. A typical session has around 30-40 interns from all backgrounds and age groups. Projects will be given based on interest and availability in the company. Teams range from agent training to marketing. Please note this is a completely remote internship you will need a reliable computer and internet connection.

How many hours will I need?

Skillbridge interns will do anywhere from 30-40 hours a week on average. Additionally, your specific Skillbridge advisor may have particular hour requirements for your internship. The internship description does state a minimum of 10 hours for Non-Skillbridge interns. We expect Skillbridge interns to be leaders in the program.

What happens after my internship?

As a small company we are not always hiring, but when we are, we prioritize current/past interns for any positions. Employment is not guaranteed at the completion of your internship. Interns also receive professional development, mentorship, and education through guest speakers, workshops, and networking events. Interns will be eligible for a letter of recommendation, reference request, resume help, and have access to our networking group and resources to assist in any future opportunities and/or job searches.
